



House Rules

Welcome to the Snowy Owl Inn. As a responsibility to all guests, these House Rules have been implemented. We believe each Snowy Owl guest has a right to a pleasurable stay; your courteous efforts to preserve these high standards will help to ensure a positive experience for everyone. Please initial each statement and sign on the bottom line as acknowledgement of these rules.

___ 10:00 pm curfew (All children are expected to be in their respective rooms with parental supervision.). This will be strictly enforced.

___ **No open containers allowed in the lobbies and public areas. (This is a state law!)**

___ Lost revenue incurred due to excessive noise or problem situations caused or created by the hockey group to guests staying at the Snowy Owl Inn is the responsibility of the hockey team leader.

___ **Running, jumping off stair landings, or skateboarding in halls and lobbies is strictly prohibited. It is the responsibility of all parents to make certain that their children observe this house rule. It is too dangerous for the children, and very disruptive to other guests to have children jumping off stair landings, and running through the halls. Our staff has been advised to tell all children (if caught running) about this house rule. After the second time, we will contact the parents. The third time we will call security.**

___ For the safety of our guests, the lookout tower - Owl's Nest - has been closed for maintenance. Please do not allow children to climb these steps. It is marked "Closed" for the safety of your children.

___ **Playing hockey in the halls, lobbies, or guest rooms is strictly prohibited. Mini hockey sticks and other equipment should remain outside of the building. If children are caught using such equipment, it shall be confiscated until checkout.**

___ Smoking is not permitted in any part of the Inn.

___ **I agree that my liability for the room charges is not waived in the event I choose to depart early. I agree to be held responsible for all actions of myself and my guest while staying at the Snowy Owl Inn.**

___ Shoes must be worn in the kitchen and dining areas.

___ **No food, no beverages, no diving, no cannonballs in the pool area. Guests will be removed and banned from the pool privileges otherwise. Management reserves the right to close the pool at any time.**

___ After check-in, please park your vehicle in the parking lot across the street. Cars left in 20-minute parking will be towed at the owner's expense.

___ **Check-in (4pm) and check-out (11am) times are firm. We realize that this may not align with hockey scheduling, but we need to clean your rooms for arrivals during the coming week, and need to enforce this schedule. In some cases a limited number of late checkouts may be made available at an additional cost of \$20.00 an hour plus tax. These rooms, however, must be requested and approved by management.**
